

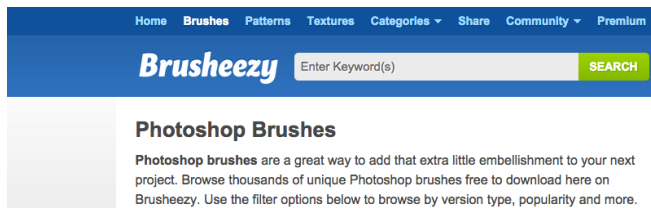
How to Download Brushes from Brusheezy.com and use in Photoshop

-Open an Internet browser and go to:

<http://www.brusheezy.com/brushes>

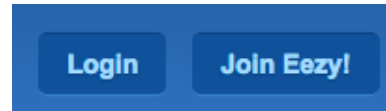
-This will direct you to pre-made brushes that you can use in Photoshop projects.

*Some of them cost money so we will not use those, but there are many that are available for free that we can use for our educational purposes.

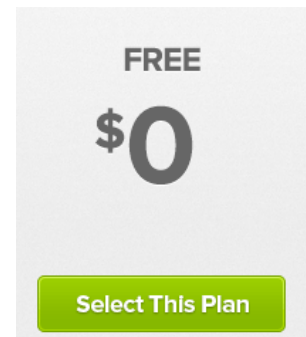


-To download brushes you will need to make a free account with brusheezy.com

-Click on Join Eezy at the top right of the page

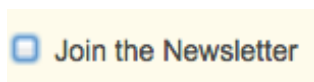


-Scroll all the way to the bottom and select the free plan



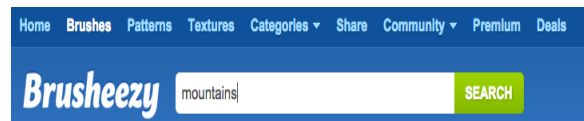
-Follow the instructions on screen to create your account.

*You may want to uncheck the Join Newsletter if you do not want to receive that.



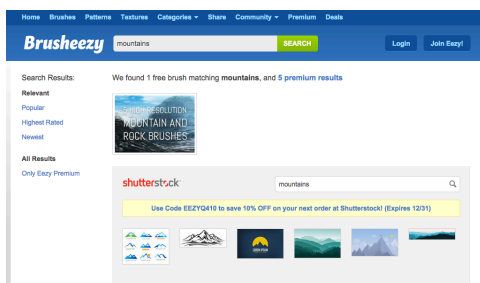
-Once you have an account you can begin searching for different bushes using the search bar on the screen.

*Make sure you are in the Photoshop brushes section

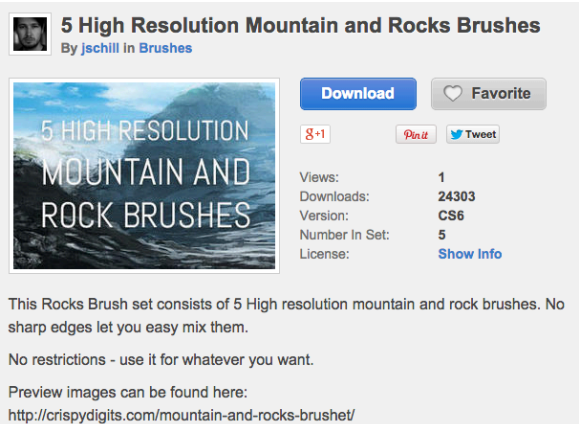


-Results from your search will show free images as well as those that cost money. We will only be using the free images for our projects.

*Images that are labeled Premium or are from shutterstock cost money

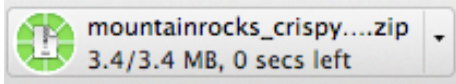


-Search and preview the types of brushes you need for your project



How to Download Brushes from Brusheezy.com and use in Photoshop

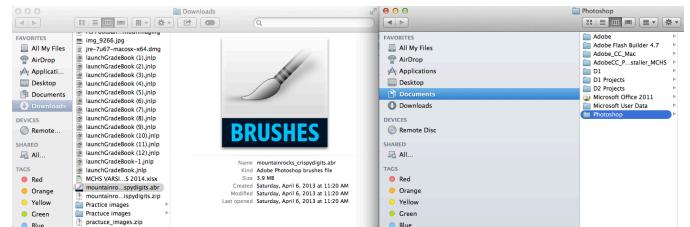
- Click the Download button to download the font you want to use.
- It will download to your Downloads folder



- If it is a zipped file, you will need to double click on it to unzip the folder

- The ABR file is what you will need to load into Photoshop for the downloaded brush to work

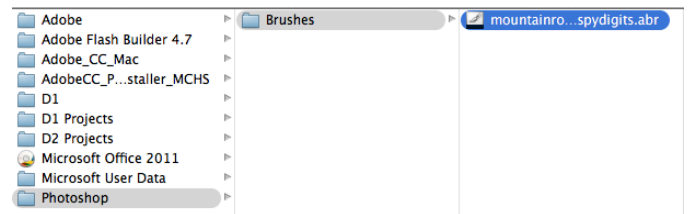
- Click on your Finder.
- Open the Downloads folder where the unzipped or ABR file for the brush is located
- Command + N to make a new finder window
- Click on your Photoshop folder in the 2nd window
- Move the two finder windows beside each other



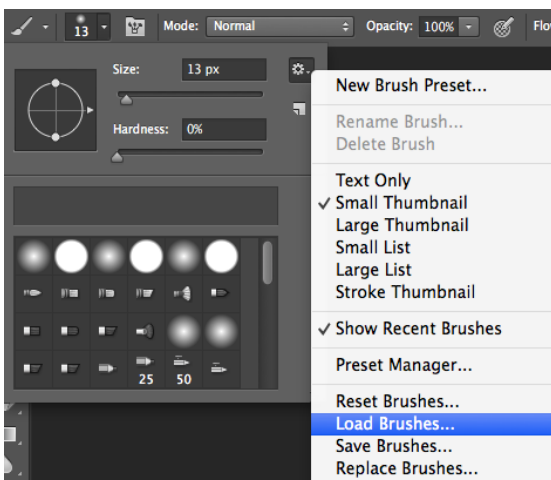
- Make a new folder inside your Photoshop folder and call it Brushes



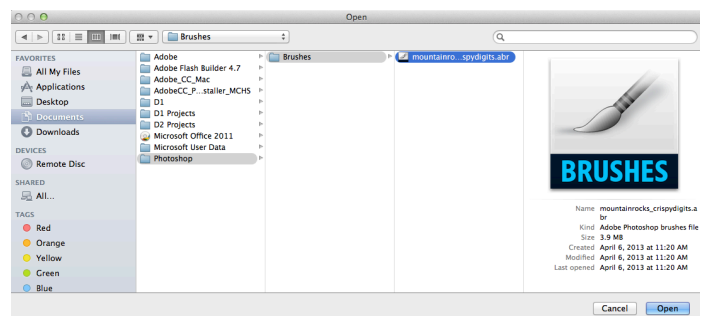
- Drag the ABR brush file from the Downloads folder to the Brushes folder you created inside your Photoshop folder
- Then close both Finder windows



- Open Photoshop and click on the Brush tool (B)
- From the sub menus up top (where you would click to choose a hard brush or a soft brush), click the drop down arrow for the brush selection
- Click on the Gear icon in the upper right of the new window
- Select Load Brushes from the next drop down



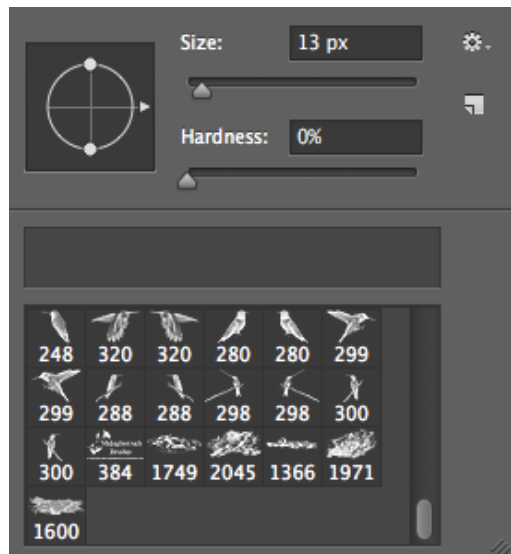
- The Open pop up window will appear
- Select the ABR brush you placed in the Brushes folder in your Documents
- Documents>Photoshop>Brushes>(ABR file)
- Click Open



How to Download Brushes from Brusheezy.com and use in Photoshop

-The Open window will disappear and the brushes are ready for use

-Scroll down to the bottom of the brush types and you will see your new downloaded brushes ready to use



-You can change the color of the brushes and the size of them with Transform (Command +T). They work just like any image you put into Photoshop

***REMEMBER to keep the brushes you paint on your project on a separate layers! So make sure you make a new layer for each click of the brush so you can alter each brush image separately however you need for your design.**
